Establishing a Dog Licensing and Control Law for the Town of Hillsdale

I. Call to order

Proof of Notice having been furnished, the Public Hearing dog licensing and control in the Town of Hillsdale, NY, was called to order by **Supervisor Art Baer** at **7:15 pm** on **December 14, 2010**, in **the Hillsdale Town Hall**.
