

HILLSDALE HAMLET COMMITTEE NOTES

Sunday, April 9, 2017 at 10 a.m.

1. Minutes from March meeting were approved.
2. Sidewalk Project and Street Lighting Update – Steve
 - a. A meeting was held with the engineering company.
 - b. Work start is expected next month.
 - c. Town Board will hold a public information meeting on April 29 to provide information; Written information will also be sent to every hamlet household.
 - d. Looks like the town will be able to use excess funds to purchase all the streetlights called for in the plan.
3. New Entry Signs and Town Hall Sign – Bart
 - a. Deposits have been made to vendors
 - b. Signs will be fabricated and there will be news soon on timing of delivery.
4. Rail Trail – Tom
 - a. Paving work will restart shortly.
5. Basketball Court Restoration – Mike Stertz
 - a. Mike has assumed responsibility for this project.
 - b. Mike met with at the site with an excavator. Contrary to previous information there is no need to dig up the existing court surface. The work will only involve repair of existing asphalt where necessary followed by recoating the entire court.
 - c. Mike will meet with Copeland Coatings, a Nassau, N.Y., firm with an extensive experience in sports-court surfaces and excellent reputation, to discuss the project further.
 - d. Now that it has been determined that the court does not need to be dug up, costs are expected to be in line with initial estimates from two years ago. This may allow purchase of new backboards, rings and nets in addition to the surface restoration work.
6. Memorial Day Weekend Flea Market. - Laura
 - a. Date will be the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend, with Sunday as rain date.
 - b. The Committee: Laura Griffin, Mike Stertz, Phyllis Ehrlich (Mike's wife), and Steve Tiger have been working on detailed plans and met immediately following the Hamlet Committee.
 - c. Hamlet Committee will do a bake sale. Other town committees will not be sharing this responsibility as previously discussed.
 - d. Many volunteers will be needed for shifts on Friday and Saturday.
