PROJECT HISTORY

- January 2011: Town Board adopts PPS Plan
- 2013: Hamlet Committee leads grant application
- January 2014: Hillsdale awarded a \$754,975 grant by NYSDOT
- May 2016: Project design approved by NYDOT
- October 20, 2016: 4 bids opened
- April 3, 2017: Preconstruction meeting


STRATEGIC GOALS

- Street calming
- Economic growth
- Historic district


DESIGN GOALS

- Provide ADA accessible pedestrian amenities along with aesthetic enhancements to the area on NYS Route 23 from White Hill Lane to NYS Route 22
- Construct well defined driveway openings to reduce pedestrian/vehicle conflicts
- Update storm water collection system as-needed
- Remove/replace/supplement traffic signs as-needed
- Add streetscape features (benches)
- Add historic lighting

FEATURES

- Sidewalks are concrete
- Curbing will be granite
- 5 crosswalks will be high-visibility
 - White reflective “ladder bar” type crosswalks will be installed
- Buffer on north side will be brick

BENCHES



MAINTENANCE

- The Town will assume responsibility for keeping new sidewalks clear of snow and ice, including the old sidewalks on Anthony Street and Cold Water streets.

SCHEDULE

- May 1 – trailer mounted signage
- May 15 – possible start of excavation
- 90-105 days
